After School Nature Camp is for 3rd, 4th, and 5th-graders. Enjoy connecting with NATURE at the Wagner Ranch Nature Area.

Sample activities include: exploring creeks and ponds, nature-focused art and science; hiking; plant and bird identification. Students will be divided into two groups (no more than 10 per group), each led by an expert naturalist.
