

Spring Nature Days Information Sheet



Here are some important details for the student's Spring Nature Day adventure.

Parents: Please plan to arrive with your student at the Nature Area Main Gate by 3:35. This will allow enough time to check in your student and ensure the program begins promptly 10 minutes later. If you emailed your [permission slip](#) in advance and received an approval, then you are good to go. If not, please bring the signed permission slip along with your student.

Students: Please wear a mask, bring small backpack with a refillable water bottle and snack, agree to maintain a distance of 6 feet from other students, and wear "camping worthy" clothing and shoes (no sandals) that may get wet or dirty. On drizzly days, a hooded jacket is recommended. Heavy rain will cancel the program. Parents will be advised the night before of a cancelled rain-day, and the make-up day plan.
