SUMMER NATURE CAMP 2021



Description: For incoming 1st graders to age 12 (divided into two age groups). Have fun exploring the creeks and ponds, meadows and woods and discovering the oldest ranch in Orinda, the Wagner Ranch Nature Area. Activities include hikes & climbs, games & crafts, creeks and pond studies and an end-of-week Friday BBQ! May also include some organic garden or building projects, for those interested. This is a fully outdoor, unplugged and in-nature experience!

Campers: Arrive by 9am, wearing a mask and sunscreen. Bring a small backpack with a refillable water bottle, a snack (for half-day campers), and a lunch (for full-day campers). Campers should wear “camping-worthy” clothing and shoes (no sandals) that may get wet or dirty. On drizzly days, a hooded jacket is recommended. Full-day campers should also pack sunscreen to reapply mid-day. We conform to county safety guidelines for COVID-19.

Enrollment: Following current COVID guidelines, we can accept a maximum of 14 campers per week. Group will divide into two (incoming 1st-4th grade in one, incoming 5th grade on up the other; ok for siblings to pair up). Each group is led by an experienced Environmental Education Teacher, and a (high school or college) Counselor.

CIT's: We invite 12-15 years old campers to enroll as a **Counselor-in-Training**, who will assist and receive training from the Teachers and Counselors.
